### DESCRIPTION

The Foyer series consists of a bench, a sofa and a lounge chair, all of which are characterised by a unique interplay between the oak frame and the upholstered seats and backrests, which almost seem to float. The series is meticulously upholstered in fabric or leather. It requires time-consuming precision and craftsmanship to upholster the seats and backrests, which feature handmade buttons. Armrests and legs on both sofa and chair are assembled from three parts, and hand-polished with the utmost care to avoid the appearance of noticeable transitions. Despite the series' delicate idiom, comfort is still central to the soft seating and backrests of the design.

#### DESIGNER

Vilhelm Theodor Lauritzen was one of Denmark's most important architects and a father of Danish Modernism. Today, many of his projects remain as lasting examples of what was then a new and revolutionary approach to architecture in which form followed function. Throughout his career, he maintained that architecture should be an applied art that serves all, not just the privileged few.


